

## Elk Point Ukrainian Dance Club – Instructor Job Posting

The Elk Point Ukrainian Dance Club is seeking an enthusiastic dance instructor to become part of our dance family!

The dance season begins in September and wraps up at the end of May. Weekly practices, with specific dates established in consultation with the instructor. Additional practice days or workshops can be scheduled as needed, with flexible use of the space.

The successful applicant shall:

- Instruct 3-5 groups of various ages and skill levels
- Choreograph a minimum of 2 dances per group (1 dance for a pre-beginner group)
- Prepare dance groups for 2-3 competitions/festivals generally held in March & April
- Prepare groups to dance as early as January for local Malanka performances
- Coordinate a final Spring Concert in May
- Teach proper technique and challenge students to grow and master their steps and skills.
- Collaborate on class placement and other club-related activities.
- Communicate regularly with the volunteer executive.
- Attend parent meetings held during class time for brief updates every 1-2 months.

Instructor Assets:

- Communicates well with parents and the volunteer board of directors
- Maintains clear communication with dancers and uses behaviour management techniques
- Creative & challenging choreography that promotes growth and skill in each dancer

Requirements:

- Valid Alberta driver's license with reliable transportation and experience driving in all Alberta weather conditions.
- Provide a Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check
- Strong communication skills and follow-through.
- At least 2 years of dance instructor experience.

This instructor position will be a one-year term, with the possibility of extension. Mileage will be included in the main salary.
